Fee Structure for 2001-2002

Annual Membership Fees

\$42 per man each semester; \$70 per man for the year

The first installment of the split payment option for Annual Membership Fees (AMFs) or the full payment of AMFs is due October 15th. The second installment for the split payment option is due March 15th.

Liability Insurance Fees

The offices of the Grand Chapter is no longer responsible for the collection of these fees. Your chapter must remit prompt payment to the Hobbs Group, Kirklin and Company, LLC. The Hobbs Group will bill you directly for these fees.

Candidate Fees

\$80 per new member

All candidate fees are due within 14 days of bid acceptance. After the 14-day deadline, the chapter becomes responsible for the candidate fee even if a candidate drops out later in the semester.

Initiation Fees

\$157 per new member; \$410 for lifetime fee

All chapters and colonies must collect the initiation fee (\$157 or \$410) from the candidate prior to initiation and remit the fee to the Offices of the Grand Chapter, postmarked within 15 days of initiation, or a \$45 penalty will be added to each late initiation fee. All initiates that pay the \$410 lifetime fee will not have to pay AMFs throughout their undergraduate career.

Conclave Savings Plan

\$150 per semester

Conclave fees are due no later than November 30th for the fall semester and April 30th for the spring semester.
