

Big and Little Brother Activity:

GOAL-SETTING SESSION

As our newest fraters become integrated into the colony, it is important that each of them set personal goals and objectives for their first year's involvement. This activity is an opportunity for each Big Brother to establish close ties with his little brother.

The goals established by the Big and Little Brother should be challenging, but not unreasonable. The Hegemon should explain each of the goal categories, while giving good examples of each.

Each Big and Little Brother establishes at least two objectives in each of the following categories.

Examples are given:

SCHOLARSHIP-	Attend at 95% of my classes; obtain at least a 3.0 GPA; take a speed-reading course.
LEADERSHIP -	Enroll in a time management course; attend a student organization leadership workshop; run for office in another student organization; chair a colony committee.
SOCIAL -	Double date with my Big / Little Brother; meet 20 new people during the coming three weeks; attend an alcohol / drug awareness seminar.
CULTURAL -	Attend a university symphony orchestra recital; go to a play; go to the ballet; enroll in a music class.
ATHLETIC -	Participate on two intramural teams; develop a work-out regimen; plan at least on exercise related activity with another frater every two weeks.
MEMBERSHIP RECRUITMENT:	Develop a membership recruitment plan for a particular individual; wear TKE apparel at least twice a week.
UNIVERSITY RESOURCES:	Meet with the university president or dean of students to discuss your interest in the campus; coordinate with the Hegemon the invitation of a professor to address the colony.
PERSONAL:	Write or phone home at least once a week; lose ten pounds; read one non-school related book once a month.
FRATERNAL:	Personally meet with all the fraters at least 15 minutes each; take my Big Brother home for the weekend;

Short and Long term goals should be set in each category.

An appropriate amount of time should be allotted for the session so that each Big & Little Brother can thoroughly develop and plan goals and explain that they are obligated to help on another.
